If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by Queen's University Belfast Development and Alumni Relations Office, or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.

If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when requested by Queen's University Belfast Development and Alumni Relations Office.
